

## Board of County Commissioners

The Ogemaw County Board of Commissioners is the governing body for the County of Ogemaw, exercising legislative and administrative functions. There are five members on the board, each elected on a partisan basis for two-year terms from districts that are approximately equal in population. Board leadership is elected for a two-year term for the board chairman and a one-year term for the board vice-chairman.

The primary functions of the board of commissioners include determination of type and level of county services, adoption of a county budget, and equalization of property values, legislative oversight services provided by the County of Ogemaw, and appointment of various advisory boards and commissions.
