

Concealed Pistol Licenses

Application Procedure

Application packets are available from the Ogemaw County Clerk's office. Packets contain all of the information you will need to complete the application process. Applicants must be 21 years of age, a U.S. citizen or resident alien and have resided in the state of Michigan for a least 6 months prior to application. Proof of pistol and safety training from a certified instructor must also be provided.

The following is a brief synopsis of the process and time frames involved with acquiring a concealed pistol license:

1. Application is made to the County Clerk office. Please bring the following information with you:
 - a. Application – completed or completed on site at day of application;
 - b. A copy of the training certificate provided by the certified instructor;
 - c. Your Michigan driver's license; and,
 - d. \$100 for a new license - \$115 for a renewal license.
2. County Clerk staff will provide instruction on fingerprinting process. Most questions are answered by reading the information contained in the CPL application packet.
3. A concealed pistol license is valid for 5 years. By law, approved concealed pistol licenses must be mailed to the applicant. Duplicate CPL are \$10.00. Additional questions may be directed to the Ogemaw County Clerk's office at 989.345.0215.
