

Dear Commissioners:


The Ogemaw County Equalization Department has prepared a statement of millage rates to be spread for the 2023 tax year as requested by the several taxing jurisdictions that levy a tax within the County of Ogemaw. The statement (old Form L-4402) which summarizes the compiled tax rates will be filed electronically with the State Tax Commission.

Each taxing unit requesting the levy of a millage has submitted the required L-4029 form certifying compliance with MCL 211.37 which states in part:

"At the annual session in October, the county board of commissioners shall not authorize the levy of a tax unless the governing body of the taxing jurisdiction has certified that the requested millage has been reduced if necessary, in compliance with Section 31 of Article 9 of the State Constitution of 1963"

It is my recommendation that the 2023 apportionment of tax rates be adopted as presented in the accompanying statement.

**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE
2023 REPORT OF TAXES TO BE APPORTIONED
PURSUANT TO THE GENERAL PROPERTY TAX ACT**

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 23-____
ADOPTED OCTOBER 12, 2023**

WHEREAS, Section 36 of the General Property Tax Act (MCL 211.36) requires each township clerk to submit to the county clerk on or before September 30 each year a statement which sets forth the amount of money to be raised in the township by taxation; and

WHEREAS, Section 37 of the Act (MCL 211.37) requires the County Board of Commissioners to hold an Apportionment Session, and approve an Apportionment Report in October of each year; and

WHEREAS, Section 52 of the Construction, Improvement, and Maintenance of Highways Act (MCL 247.452) requires that the Board of Commissioners approve the Annual Apportionment Report at their annual October meeting; and

WHEREAS, at the annual Apportionment Session, the County Board of Commissioners must examine documents and records submitted to the Board that show the amount of money to be raised by ad valorem levies in each township or city for schools, highways, drains, township and city operations and all other purposes as authorized by law and required the correction of any defects or omissions with regard to those levies; and

WHEREAS, the action of the County Board of Commissioners concerning the spread of these levies is final, except in situations where a change is made to the equalization of the county through an equalization appeal to the Michigan Tax Tribunal or a levy passed at the November elections; and

WHEREAS, the action of the County Board of Commissioners for 2023 will be the official authorizing for 30 taxing authorities within the County to levy property taxes for 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Ogemaw County Equalization Department has prepared an Apportionment Report for consideration by the Ogemaw County Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Apportionment Report, upon approval, will provide final authorization for the levy of property taxes upon which taxing authorities depend to provide educational, health, economic development, public safety, and other services which are important to the wellbeing of the County economy and Ogemaw County residents.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the 2023 Report of Taxes to be Apportioned showing the millage levies apportioned to various taxing authorities in Ogemaw County for the year 2023 is hereby approved in accordance with Section 37 of the General Property Tax Act (MCL 211.37); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Ogemaw County Board of Commissioners, under the authority of MCL 211.37, directs that the millage rates specified in the attached 2023 Report of Taxes to be Apportioned for townships, cities, schools and all other purposes as authorized by law shall be spread against the taxable value of properties on the proper assessment rolls of the townships, cities in the County.
